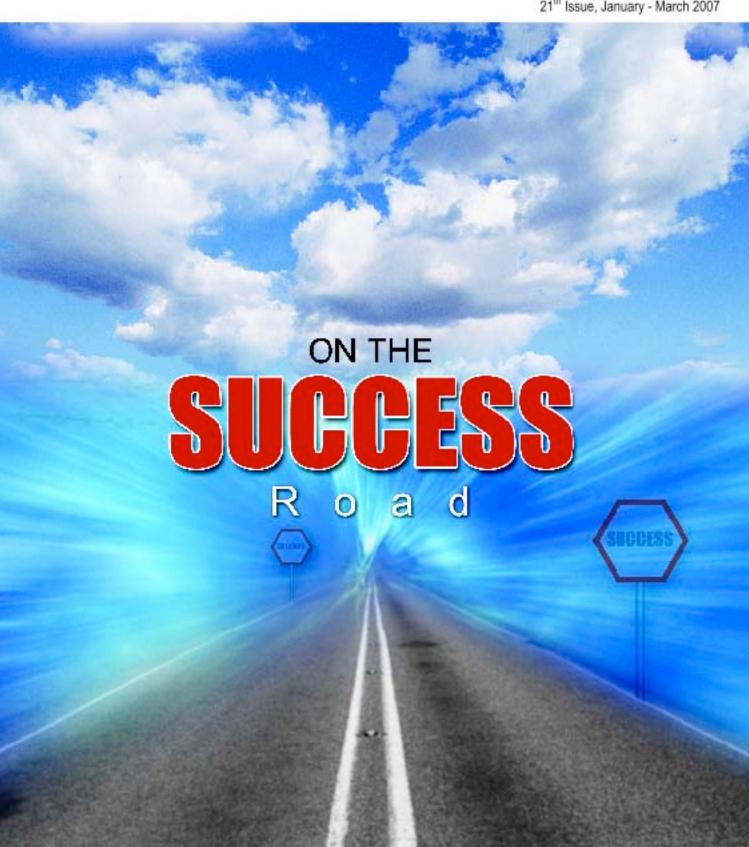
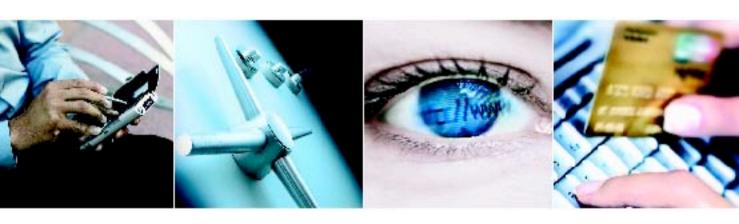

# ACT Supports IT-Security "made in Germany" Initiative

On 13th November 2006, the Marriott Hotel, Cairo has witnessed the IT Security "made in Germany" Road show 2006, a German initiative that intends to support cooperation between German suppliers of IT security solutions and partners in foreign countries, especially Arabian countries. The initiative is a network of manufacturers, system integrators, service providers, research institutes and public services.

IT security is one of the fast growing markets in the ICT field. The value of IT security products in Germany for 2005 is about 4.6 billion USD, an increase of 1.1 per cent is expected. Germany is leading in developing IT and security projects; its products and competences are at the forefront of this technology evolution.

ACT - represented by Mr. Hassanien Tawfiq the Chairman of the ICT Committee in the German-Arab Chamber of Industry and Commerce- has always encouraged joint projects of German companies and partners from the Middle East.

Mr. Hassanien stated in his opening speech that he had personally witnessed

Kamel brought to life the story so far, illustrating the dedication and long hours that had gone into developing the integrated plan for the restructuring process ñ the benefits of which we are all able to reap today.

Kamel has lofty goals - a computer for every home, widespread broadband and further development of the smart village, with plausible initiatives and rigorous restructuring these goals seem feasible. With internet users up from half a million (2000) to 5 million (2006) apparently the MCIT knows how to get results.

The penetration of fixed lines has reached 1.1 million and Egyptian Telecommunication reports continued growth that is unparalleled internationally. The private sector has also witnessed a transformation - the third mobile network is an example of this, coupled with the service provision telecommunications they yield promising annual returns.

After the completion of his speech the floor was opened for questions. Kamel deftly responded to queries regarding Wimax, the third mobile generation and the international gateway.

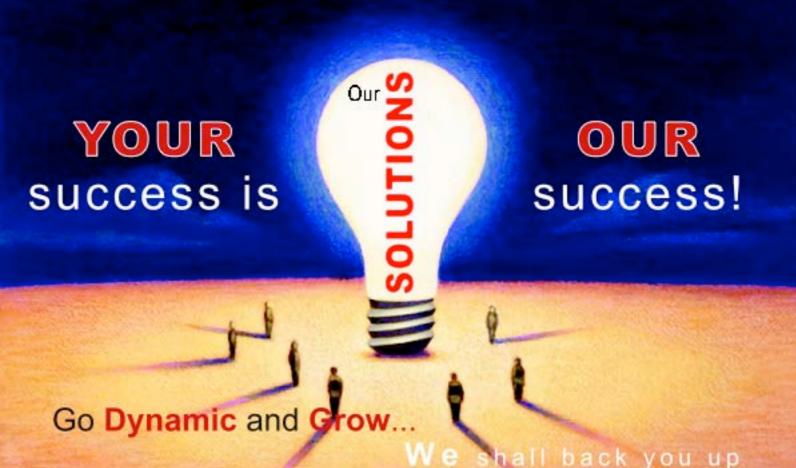






## ACT in GITEX
