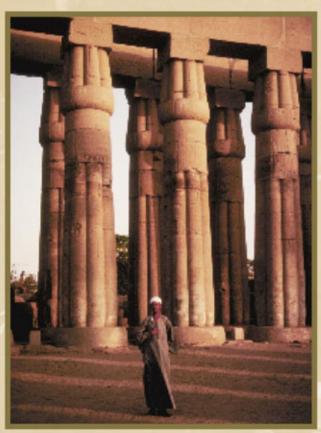

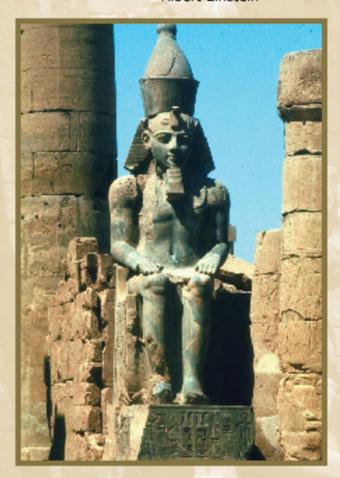
No country has succeeded without educating its people; education is the key to sustaining national growth.

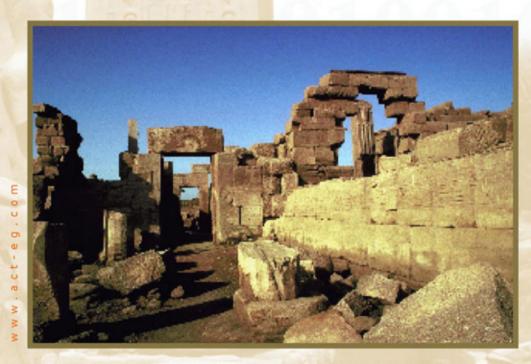

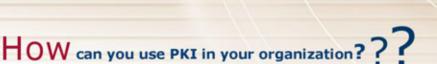

This is carried out by software at a CA, possibly under human supervision, together with other coordinated software at distributed locations. For each user, the user identity, the public key, their binding, validity conditions and other attributes are made unforgeable in public key certificates issued by the CA.

PKI has many uses, including providing public keys and bindings to user identities which are used for:

- Encryption and/or sender authentication of Email messages
- Encryption and/or authentication of documents
- Authentication of users to applications
- Bootstrapping secure communication protocols, such as Internet key exchange (IKE) and SSL.
 In both of these, initial set-up of a secure channel (a "security association") uses asymmetric
 key (a.k.a. public key) methods, whereas actual communication uses faster secret key (a.k.a.
 symmetric key) methods.

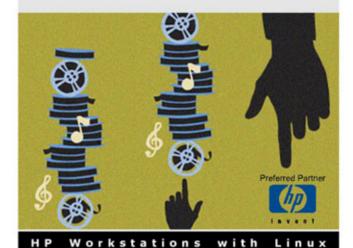

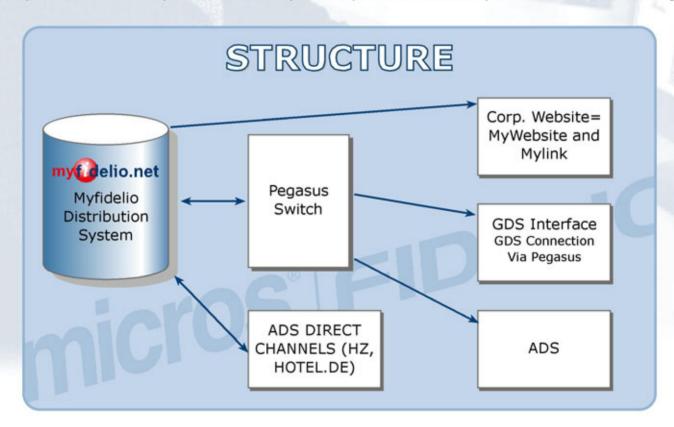
